DCRB CIRCULAR NO. 930

To All Members of the DCRB:

Re: **DATA REPORTING - WORKERS COMPENSATION TERRORISM DATA FOR
FEDERAL INSURANCE OFFICE – SECTION 111 OF TRIPRA OF 2015**

The United States Department of the Treasury's Federal Insurance Office (FIO) has implemented their data collection provisions for 2017 as part of Section 111 of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act (TRIPRA) of 2015. The provisions of this Call require carriers to report terrorism insurance data in accordance with Section 111.

After careful consideration the Delaware Compensation Rating Bureau, Inc. (DCRB) Governing Board voted to approve having the DCRB provide the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) with workers compensation terrorism insurance data related to this initiative.

This year's Call for aggregated workers compensation data will be based on Policy Year 2016 (all policies issued in 2016) and will be summarized at the NAIC company/group level. This data will be provided to FIO's aggregator and combined with the group's other lines of business. All identifiable company names and IDs will be masked prior to submission to FIO.

Consequently, DCRB member carriers do not need to take action for FIO's data collection provisions for workers compensation, with the exception of providing reinsurance information in accordance with the Call for all lines of insurance (including workers compensation).
